### HOT BEDS

The old tobacco kilns are a signature of the Alpine Valleys and some have had a cunning transformation into tourist accommodation. Kilnhouse has two venues near Porepunkah. Cavedon's Kilnhouse appears as two old tobacco kilns and a shed in the middle of

the paddock, but up-close, it's an architecturally designed sensation – simple, sophisticated, modern and luxurious.

A writer's retreat? With wireless internet connection and a desk that overlooks snow capped Mt Feathertop, the silence (apart from the kookaburras and the cows) make the Kilns ideal as a work retreat.

The Chinaman's Kilnhouse was named after the nearby Chinamans waterhole in the Ovens River, accessed from Cavedons Lane Chinaman's Kilnhouse reflects the close association between early Chinese settlement and the Ovens and Buckland Valleys.
